## APPLICANTS MUST BE EITHER:

1. Classroom educators employed in Jewish education in a local Jewish school or synagogue.

### AND/OR

2. A local Jewish school or synagogue. Eligible programs must be hosted by a recognized Jewish institution or reputable educational institution.

## APPLICATION TYPE

We offer two application options, one for individuals and one for institutions. Please select the one that best matches your needs.

## APPLICATION DEADLINES

Grants are awarded through two cycles each year. Cycle One applications are due April 30, 2026. Cycle Two applications are due November 17, 2026.
